Dear Parents and Tutors,
I hope you have all settled in well to your school routine.

Home Tutor Seminar: This will be in week 5 at the Goldfields Camp School.

Monday: Travel day is on the Monday and this is a Public Holiday. You will be able to avail yourself of the camp school. As there will be no staff on duty during this public holiday, we have made arrangements for keys to be left in dormitory doors allocated to Kalg SOTA. You will need to contact Robyn at the school beforehand to get the code for the main door. You will need to provide your own lunch & dinner on Monday. All other meals are catered for. Please do not arrive at Camp School before 12 noon.

Tuesday to Friday: Seminar will start with breakfast and run through until assembly is completed on the Friday. All staff will be in attendance. A dual program runs during seminar and a draft timetable for students and tutors will be emailed to you soon.

Please note a lot of teacher time goes into preparing for this and it is important that tutors attend the sessions on time. Attendance is required from 8:30 to 3:30. I would appreciate people being on time wherever possible.

Sessions for Tutors will start at 8:30 and finish at 3:30. There will be materials for chart making in one of the classrooms, a couple of computers for use, and programs of work to look at and discuss after compulsory sessions if you wish to. Please note adults are free after 3:30 but please let us know if you are taking children out of camp as teachers have a duty of care for all enrolled children during the camp.

Occasional Daycare: The school will make three bookings for parents so they can place their babies and toddlers if they wish.

Dental: We have a block set aside at the South Kalgoorlie Dental clinic. You need to ring them to book between 9-12 On the Wed. Please ring for a booking on 90213379.

Meetings: All three meetings will be held on Tuesday afternoon from 3:30 and hopefully finished by 5.

Health checks will take place on Tuesday morning.

Travel Subsidy, Accommodation and meals: There is a travel subsidy for driving your vehicle into seminar. All meals and accommodation is paid for by the school.
